February 13, 2024

Secretary Matthew called the meeting to order at 7:30 in President Randy and Vice President Nick's absence.

There were two visitors this evening. I thought I could remember their names, so failed to write them down. I have forgotten, so my apologies. I believe both have signed up as members, so I'll be seeing them again.

Old Business:

- Matthew went through some of the highlights of December since there was no meeting in January due to the weather.
- Matthew talked a little about Dave's memorial at the end of December. It was well attended, and he had full military honors.

New Business:

- Burt will lead the program next month with Alternate Collections being the topic. Please bring something to share and we'll have each person talk for about 5 minutes on their Hobby. Mike will talk about roll searching in April. Owen will do his in May and his topic is yet to be determined. June is our Picnic at Long's Park at 6p. Justin will reserve the picnic area.
- The Wichita Show the 16th and 17th was discussed.
- Treasurer Justin reported that \$1643.83 was in the bank. Please renew if you haven't yet.
- Some ideas were tossed around on how to expand the club. A flyer will be created for the show to help draw in members (Owen and I are working on that). Other ideas seemed to fizzle out. I've asked the membership to think about it between now and the March meeting.
- Allan talked about his trip to FUN (Florida United Numismatists). There were over 400 dealers with unique coins from all over the world.

- I talked about the coinage in Britain making its final transitional changes from Queen Elizabeth to King Charles. The comment was that the King's health isn't looking so good so may have another transition sooner than later.
- The 2019 Apollo 11 5oz coin won the 2023 Mint Directors conference "Best Collectable Silver Coin, adding to its already award-winning resume.

Allan presented "How to Put on a Coin Show." Some of the highlights were:

- We need volunteers!
- This is our club's money maker, so we need our best foot forward and volunteers to help that.
- Advertising is going out.
- 12 tables confirmed, but others are also coming in.
- This year the move to Saturday ran into a conflict, so it was moved back to Sunday.
- We need donations for prizes for the raffle. The club is purchasing a Manhattan National Note for the top prize (probably worth \$200+ but acquired at a discount at \$150).
- This year, we need to ramp up security. Be on the lookout for shady people and dealings.
