Randy gave a program on Colonial Money. I was surprised to learn that there is a distinction of Continental Currency. See if you can spot it among the pictures I took.

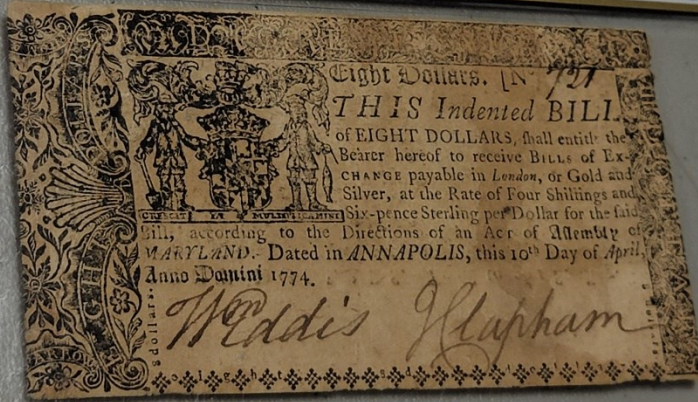


Maryland / Colonial Currency
